In 2011 AIS responded to the Alliant Small Business RFP for the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) Windows 7 Deployment Support Services and was awarded the contract within weeks. The Windows 7 Deployment project provides the necessary support services allowing for the successful migration of the entire VA enterprise (desktops, laptops, infrastructure, and clinical devices) to the new Microsoft Windows 7 operating system (OS). The scope and scale of the project is comprehensive. The project includes the building and testing the compatibility of critical application packages, building a desktop hosting environment, while providing Windows 7 and Office 2010 help desk support and end user training available to the 325,000 members serving our Veterans.
