### DELTA PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Designed, developed, and operated by AIS since 2007, FBI's Delta project is a comprehensive solution built on Microsoft's SharePoint platform that manages the FBI's Confidential Human Sources, including capabilities for automated compliance, search, reporting, data aggregation, document templates, and automated workflows. AIS developed highly secure authentication to limit access to certain types of highly sensitive information while also expanding FBI Analyst access to non-identifying intelligence, in compliance with Attorney General Guidelines for Managing Confidential Human Sources (2006). Delta is the first enterprise application to utilize the FBI's Public Key Infrastructure (PKI) and the first certified Electronic Record Keeping System at the FBI. Currently, the Delta solution is used by 17,000 users and over 1 million records have been created to date.

The original solution was developed within 6 months, fielded less than 3 months after C&A and independent testing and has experienced less than 3 hours of unscheduled downtime over the life of the program. AIS has delivered 13 major and 10 minor versions over the application lifecycle.
